Our 2023 Projects

1 In 2023, HS Foundation undertook a meaningful project to support vulnerable children at Lerato Children's Home in Mutare during the winter season. Our initiative involved donating winter jackets to ensure that these children have warmth and protection during the cold months. By providing these essential winter garments, we aimed to bring comfort and alleviate the challenges faced by these children, ensuring they could face the cold weather with resilience and dignity. Through this project, HS Foundation demonstrated its commitment to improving the well-being and quality of life for vulnerable children in the community.



2 In 2023, HS Foundation embarked on a significant project to support girls at Hanwa Mission, a rural high school and primary school in Macheke. Our initiative focused on donating sanitary pads to these girls, recognizing the importance of menstrual hygiene management and the challenges faced by girls in accessing menstrual products. By providing sanitary pads, we aimed to promote their health, well-being, and educational opportunities by ensuring they could manage their menstruation comfortably and confidently. Through this project, HS Foundation demonstrated its commitment to addressing gender-related barriers to education and empowering girls in underserved communities.

 - 2. Conducted a street food donation in Mutare to support individuals experiencing homelessness.**

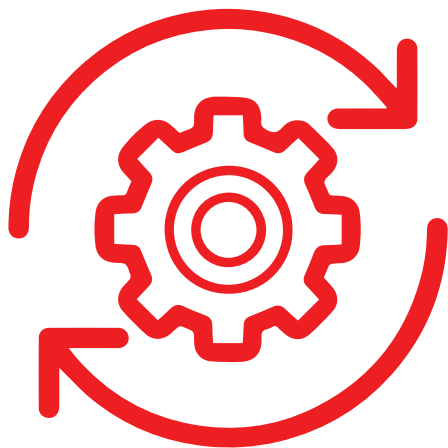
